| <u>Client Advocates*</u> meet with medical clients, build a trusting relationship, & serve as a guide for their care with the PRC.   | At least 2   |
| Nurses* are vital to the medical services we provide, using their credentials & medical knowledge to educate clients & provide pregnancy tests/ultrasounds.  | At least 2   |
| Mentors* meet with clients weekly, building a relationship with them & use curriculum to educate on their role as a parent.  | At least 6 female<br>1 male<br>1 spanish speaking                              |
| <u>Curbside Care</u> volunteers serve for 3-4 hours once monthly during Curbside Care events, visiting with clients at their car & provide diapers, wipes, & gently used clothes.                    | At least 4   |
| <b>Boutique Volunteers*</b> help organize & restock the Baby Boutique where expecting parents "shop" for baby items.   | 1  |
| <b>Receptionists*</b> are trained as the frontline of the ministry & the first face to greet clients as they come in, handle sensitive phone calls, schedule appointments, & other office functions. | Monday 11-1pm<br>Tuesday 9-11:30am<br>Tuesday 1:30-4:30pm<br>Wednesday all day |
| Office Support* volunteers assist with filing, receipts, pledge reminders & mailings.  | 1  |
| Post Abortion Support* volunteers meet with clients that have an abortion in their past & help them begin their healing.   | 2  |
| Willow Story* volunteers meet with clients who have experienced a pregnancy loss or have been given a prenatal diagnosis to be a companion through grief.  | 2  |

| Overnight Volunteers encourage & connect with residents at either Magnolia House or Merci's Refuge. Arrive around 6:30pm and stay overnight in a private room.                                     | At least 5 willing to do<br>1-2 nights per month |
| <u>Program Leaders</u> help lead or co-lead varying classes & programs, such as life skills topics, Bible studies, etc.  | At least 3                                       |
| Office Support volunteers help with answering phones, processing in-kind donations, logging volunteer hours, & recording receipts.   | 1  |
| Mentors meet with a specific resident for about an hour each week, constantly pray for her, encourage & support her in various ways.   | 3  |
| <u>Childcare</u> volunteers help provide short-term childcare for residents for the children at Magnolia House while the resident is in class, programming, job searching, or applying for school. | 2  |
