Living Alternatives Pregnancy Resource Center is a 501c3 nonprofit organization established in 1985. Each year, we continue to grow a little stronger, do things a little better, and gain a new perspective on where God is leading us next. After adding Magnolia House, Logansport, and our Campus Satellite in 2025, we are blessed to now serve in **12 medical clinics** and **3 residential homes** across these **12 communities**:

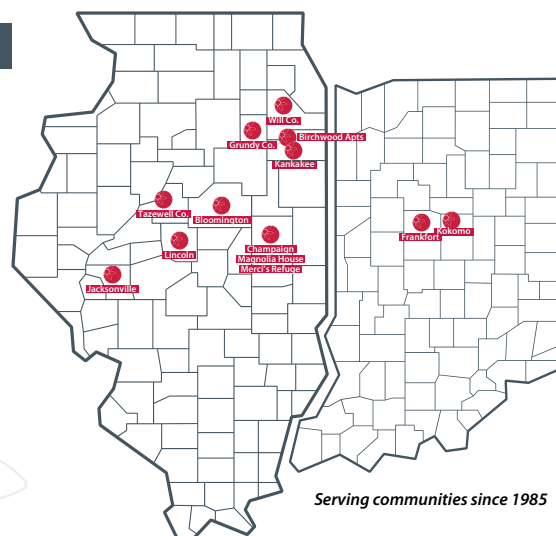

A Year of Immeasurably More

The Lord answered our prayers in 2025, continually reminding us that He is able to do immeasurably more than we could ask or imagine (Ephesians 3:20–21). He opened doors to more opportunities, more life-changing conversations, more locations, more volunteers, and more faithful partners investing in this ministry. God exceeded our expectations, deepening our faith in who He is and revealing the many ways He desires to be glorified through each of us.

Living Alternatives Pregnancy Resource Center is a faith-based organization committed to honoring God by providing excellent care, compassionate support, and honest information to those facing pregnancy decisions through authentic relationships that display grace, honor life, and foster community.

In 2025, we celebrated the opportunity to serve **4,418 clients**, including 2,737 who came to us for the first time. Through **13,016 client visits**, we provided **1,732 pregnancy tests** (with 92% receiving a positive result) and **2,333 ultrasounds**. Of those we served, 276 were considering abortion. While we may not know the next step of every individual who walked through our doors, we do know that 118 left our pregnancy resource centers stating they no longer felt the need to pursue abortion.

We also celebrated **253 gospel presentations** and **2,485 spiritual conversations** with individuals who did not claim faith in God. Our teams taught **3,275 parenting education classes**, welcomed **3,525 cars** through Curbside Care, supported **24 individuals** through Deeper Still retreats for post-abortion healing, and cared for **37 families** through our Willow Story perinatal grief support program.

God's work has continued in 2026! Already, **2,437 clients** have received care at our medical clinics, and **10 women** attended our spring Deeper Still retreat. All three of our residential homes have been filled with women seeking God's purpose for their lives, while **15 families** are currently receiving support through Willow Story. Most significantly, **71 women** have courageously changed their abortion plans after discovering hope in the life God has planned for their unborn babies, and for themselves.

God truly did immeasurably more in 2025, and He continues to place beautiful opportunities before us in 2026. Join us as we **Dare to Believe** for all He has ahead — for this ministry and for every individual we are privileged to walk alongside!

In February of 2025, we opened Magnolia House — our third residential program. This beautiful home in Champaign, IL, has become a safe place where some of our youngest moms can live with their little ones.

In June of 2025, our mobile clinic pulled into Logansport, Indiana — a community full of opportunities to serve immigrants from around the world. With the support and encouragement of the community, we found the perfect location to continue offering medical services throughout the winter and into 2026.

In August of 2025, we welcomed our first patient at our Campus Satellite in Champaign, IL. The Lord has given us many opportunities to serve both students and the surrounding neighborhood as He has strategically positioned us where she needs us to be.

Our growth has continued in 2026 with the launch of our new podcast, *The Next Step*. We are excited to extend the heart and mission of LAPRC beyond the walls of our centers through meaningful conversations, real stories, and practical support. Keep reading to learn more!

This August, our mobile clinic is getting a facelift with fresh LAPRC branding. We are excited for this refresh as we relocate the mobile clinic to Lincoln, where we will continue serving women and families throughout Logan County.
